ISLAND SANCTUARY

Offering luxury and quiet seclusion set within an exotic tropical garden setting, Amara Sanctuary Resort is the perfect getaway from the city centre.

THE SCENE

A stylish resort surrounded by lush tropical gardens located on Sentosa Island, the Amara Sanctuary Resort sits on the site of the historic British Sergeants' Quarters built in the 1930s. Blending colonnaded colonial architecture (two colonial heritage buildings now house the Verandah and Courtyard Suites) contemporary design and tropical landscape, it offers casual chic accommodation just minutes away from the city centre. In close proximity are Singapore Cruise Centre, Sentosa Golf Club, and the Lion City's newest ode to retail therapy, Vivo City, and St James Powerhouse for night revellers.

THE ROOMS

My Deluxe Room one of 91 (deluxe or premier) in the modern Sanctuary building was a sleek 36 sqm and contemporary styled with a garden view. The room facilities are designed with business and leisure travellers in mind and include the usual facilities like broadband Internet access, satellite and cable TV and IDD phones with voice messaging systems. Also on offer are 20 Colonial Suites (eight Verandah Suites with outdoor patio and 12 Courtyard Suites with outdoor Jacuzzis) and 10 one- and two-bedroom villas with private plunge pools and personal butler service.

DRINK & DINE

Four outlets offer a variety of options; Shutters, an elegant all-day restaurant serves Asian and Western dishes in an open-kitchen concept. Renowned for its cuisine and impeccable service, Thanying features a menu of contemporary Royal Thai delicacies designed by Thai celebrity

chef Chalie Amatyakul. Si Bon, an intimate Japanese restaurant in a historic, converted chapel, offers skewered Japanese food called Kushikatsu for just 13 guests. Chic beachside eatery Silk Road of the Sea, serves fresh seafood from regions in China inspired by a journey Marco Polo made in the 13th century. Tipplers can make a stop for a selection of signature cocktails at the Upper Tiers bar.

OTHER FEATURES

The resort has its own tennis court, jogging track and three outdoor pools. The roof top infinity pool with views of the South China Sea and reserved exclusively for adult guests. A full-service spa and gym are expected to open by the year-end. MICE facilities include a pillar-less Grand Ballroom, with special effects Gobo lighting, video conferencing, and simultaneous translation technology that can accommodate up to 500 guests.

SOMETHING SPECIAL

The stunning Glass Pavilion sited within the lushly landscaped grounds is ideal for a romantic and elegant wedding. Furnished with stylish transparent Philippe Starck-designed 'Louis Ghost Chairs' it can seat up to 40 guests. Adding to its charm is an antique bell and a waterfall that serves as a picturesque backdrop to the pavilion.
